

WHAT CAN YOUR PRIMARY CARE PHYSICIAN DO FOR YOU?

Your PCP provider is your first point of contact and most likely will be the first to see signs of things like depression, chronic disease, or other health concerns. Their job is to make sure you get the right care in a way that fits your needs and values. This could include managing those symptoms or referring you to a specialist when necessary.

SAME-DAY APPOINTMENTS WITH A PRIMARY CARE PHYSICIAN:

Many primary care providers offer same-day appointments for urgent needs. If your PCP is already booked for that day, you may be able to see another provider for a same-day appointment.

ACCESSING CARE OUTSIDE OF CLINIC HOURS:

If you are experiencing an urgent but non-life-threatening condition outside of scheduled office hours, you may reach the on-call physician by calling your primary care physician's office.

If you are a new patient, want to schedule an appointment, or have any questions please call your primary care physician's office.
